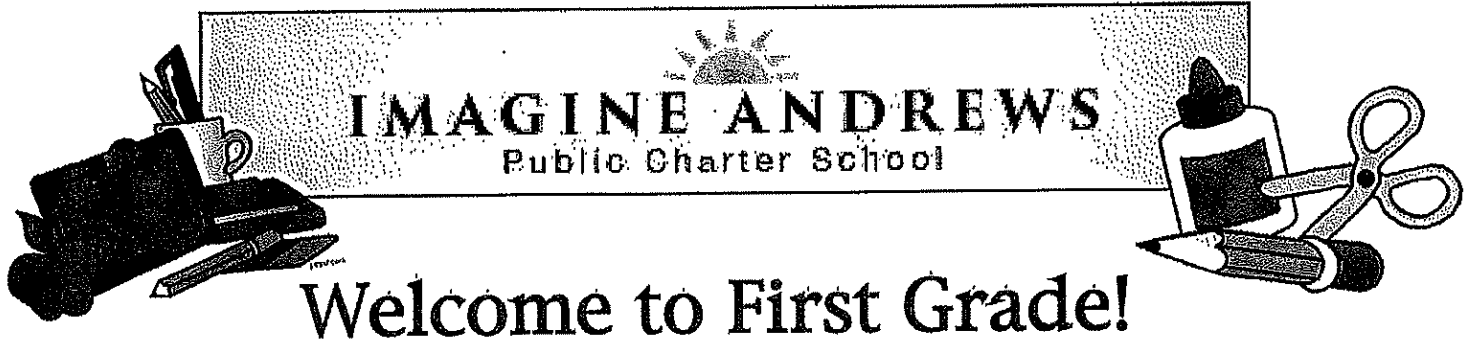

- 2 packages (4 pack) dry erase markers
- 2 boxes of Kleenex

- 1 Germ-X or Hand Sanitizer
- 1 pair of scissors
- 4 pink erasers
- 1 rectangle shaped pencil box
- 2 boxes of crayons (24) UNOPENED
- 1 package of colored pencils
- 1 clipboard

Students will share supplies within the classroom, so please do not write your child's names on the items. If you are able to supply extras of any of these supplies, they will be put to good use by all of the children in the class.

Attached are the supplies scholars will need in the 2018-19 academic year. Some of the supplies are community supplies, as they will be shared, while others will be used for your child only. Sharing supplies is beneficial as scholars have always been equipped with pencils, paper, glue, scissors, and coloring materials whenever needed.

Community Supplies

1. 3 Packs of Pencils (Preferably #2 pencils because they fit most pencil sharpeners.)
2. 2 Packs of Glue Sticks
3. 2 Pairs of Scissors
4. 2 Packs of Crayons (24 count or more washable crayons)
5. 2 Packs of Markers (12 count or more washable markers. Please do not send "smelly" markers.)
6. 2 Packs of Colored Pencils
7. 2 Packs of Wide-Ruled Notebook Paper
8. 2 Packs of Highlighters
9. 1 Pack of Construction Paper
10. 3 Pack of tissue boxes

Optional Donation for Community Use

- a. 1 Pack of Blank Award Certificates (We use them for Student of the Week. Blank ones are sold at Staples and Office Depot)

Personal Supplies

1. 6 Composition Journals (2 for math, 1 for Science/Health, 1 for Social Studies, 1 Reading, 1 for Writing). Please write your child's name and the subject on each journal.
2. 5 "three-hole clasp" Folders (3 for Classwork (1 Reading, 1 Math, 1 Science/S.S., 1 for Specials, 1 for Homework).
 - a. Please write your child's name and the designation of each folder on the folder.
Example: *"Jonathan Harris, Homework folder"*
 - b. Colors:
 - i. Classwork: 1 Red, 1 Blue, 1 Green
 - ii. Homework: Any color/design (please label it "Homework.")
 - iii. Specials: Purple
