The School Leader Report Included:

- **Academic Achievement:** Star Gains in Reading and Math were reviewed.
- **Economic Sustainability:** Reviewed Economic Sustainability Report. Current enrollment 434 as of 12/1/20.
- **Financial Sustainability:** The current financial situation was revealed, based on 434 students applied to the Prince George's County per pupil formula.
- **Character Development:** Imagine Andrews applied to be a National School of Character. The school has advanced to the second round of consideration.
- **Shared Values.** Shared Values focused on Justice, responding to parental concerns over the amount of time scholars spend in the virtual learning environment.

- **School Development**: Dave Miller provided details on what a hybrid model reopening would look like, current repair projects at the school, addressing environmental concerns and provided the latest modified timeline on the installation of the modular units.
- **Parent Choice:** Mr. Rice conducted a virtual Q&A with questions pre-received and then answered via video.
